MEETING MINUTES

1. Attendance: Anthony R. Banks, Jeff Connor, Alan Rubenstein, Michael Everett, and Deborah Day, Co-Chair.

The committee began when called to order at approximately 9:20 a.m. by Co-Chair, Dr. Deborah Day.

- a. The committee readdressed the issue of a directory. There was a consensus that to be in the directory you must pay so there would be no presumption of endorsement. The directory would be organized by specialty and potentially geographic areas. The directory would be on the Family Law website rather than made into a hard copy. This eliminates the cost of printing and mailing.
- b. The list serve continues to be discussed. The list serve lacks confidentiality and there were some concerns about attorney comments being used later. The committee feels that it should be a monitored list serve, although there are no recommendations of who may do that. The committee also believes that only section members should be able to use the list serve. There would be rules published and required to be adhered to.
- c. The committee agreed that Mike would explore the online directory through connections he has with FICPA, who has already produced a directory in this manner.
- d. Tony Banks would gather information regarding the list serve recommendations (i.e., rules, monitoring) and contact Eddie Stevens and Robin Sher.
- e. The committee will set a telephone conference at the end of February. Dr. Day will provide two dates for potential meetings.
- f. The committee will meet again on June 24, 2009 at the Annual Convention in Orlando, Florida.
