
Re: Family Law Form update

It is our understanding that the Supreme Court is currently drafting parenting plan forms to conform with the recent changes to Chapter 61, Florida Statutes. In the interim, we have prepared parenting plan forms and instructions for use in the Sixth Judicial Circuit. Pursuant to the requirements of Florida Family Law Rule of Procedure 12.750, the following forms listed below have been approved by me for use in this circuit until release of the Supreme Court parenting plan forms:
