In addition, there will be a discussion of new options for active military personnel and their timesharing and information regarding the newly created "concurrent custody".

This seminar will also provide practice tips and ideas about effective dates and will address how the new laws will impact your current, pending and future cases, as well as closed cases and modification actions.
